Vendor responsibilities:

1. You must provide small samples of some chocolate product. (If you are selling food items, the samples should be samples of the chocolate food/product that you are selling. If you are offering a game or activity, or selling crafts or other merchandise - your chocolate sample can be any good-quality chocolate item, cut into small pieces.
2. Food items should be **unique** to each booth.. Please check with organizers to be sure that your item is the only one of its kind. To help us avoid duplicate food sales, you must **notify the Chamber of any change to your planned food item.**
3. The Chamber will be selling hot dogs and sodas. Other vendors may not sell these items.
4. Booths should be set up and ready for sales by 9:00 a.m. (10:00 a.m. for food booths). The Chamber reserves the right to bar any duplicate food item sales, or any craft items deemed offensive or in poor taste.
5. You are responsible for your own tax status and for collecting and reporting sales tax where applicable.

The Chamber requests that all booths be registered no later than September 30, 2010. Booth spaces are 10x10. Booth fee is \$25 and is non-refundable.
